It has been noted that yellow fleshed potatoes are less susceptible to blight.

Agria- Late variety with yellow flesh. Stores well if grown organically.

All Reds –Mid to late potato with red flesh tubers and red skin that keeps its colour when cooked. A moist and flavourful variety.

Banana – Late with banana shaped tubers, with yellow flesh and waxy yellow skins. Good salad potato.

Desiree – Late season, red skinned with pale yellow flesh. Good storage and cooking potato.

Estima - Mid-season yellow fleshed brown skinned potato good for cooking.

Fianna - Early, white fleshed tuber similar to Yukon Gold.

French Fingerling - Late oblong tubers with red skin, light yellow flesh and waxy texture. It grows and sets fairly heavy.

German Butterball - Late, yellow flesh, great for eating fresh or storing throughout the winter.

Gold Rush – Mid-season, good size and yields, russet skin with white flesh, great for baking and storage.

Kennebec- Mid to late season, white fleshed large potatoes great for mashing and frying.

Norland - Early, red-skinned potato, white flesh. Has some resistance to scab and black scurf. Stores well.

Onaway - Early, white variety with round tubers.

Red Chieftain - Mid to late season, red skin, white flesh. Good all around use potato. Stores well. Has good disease resistance.

Russet Burbank (Netted Gem) - Late season, heirloom with white flesh and heavy netted russet skin. Good storage, and good all purpose potato.

Russian Blue - Late maturing, dark blue skin and flesh with round to oblong tubers. A heavy setting large plant should be spaced 12” or more apart to get them to full maturity. Nice flavour boiled.

Sieglinde – Mid to late, yellow flesh with smooth tubers great for eating fresh or storing throughout the winter. Chefs love this “German Butterball” type potato.

Yukon Gold – Early maturing, yellow skin and flesh, shallow pink eyes. Has a great taste and good storage. Not a heavy producer. Recommend to plant Single Drop only.
